Our ministry remains steadfast in its mission to serve those in need, expanding our reach to provide essential services to as many people as possible. With your support, we provided 14 million pounds of food to over 53,000 individuals and engaged 532 people in meaningful discussions on Freedom of Religion.

Despite limited resources, we have made significant strides in promoting human rights and advancing democracy in these countries.
